



TAKE THE 50 WORD STORY CHALLENGE AND ENTER THE JCSP COMPETITION



This competition is an opportunity for students to think about and create their own 50 word story. Students are required to write a story, either individually or in a group, that has a maximum word count of 50 words. If students would like to attach an image or drawing to their story this is fine but not a requirement. The stories can be based on any topic which interests the student or class and the only requirement is that the word count is adhered to. Keep in mind JCSP statements can be used in relation to this competition and some of the literacy initiatives will support student's work. Prizes for individual and group categories. Entries can be in Irish, English, French...

Success Criteria Include:

- 1. Creative and original work produced by student/s
- 2. The story is presented in a clear manner use of headings/images
- 3. The word count is adhered to

Closing date for the 50 word story competition is Friday the 16th of December
