

Competition time!

This competition is an opportunity for students to showcase their creative skills and write a short account of a day in the life of a young person in Ireland in 2020. The piece can reflect a young person's everyday life in Ireland or it can be an imaginary piece of writing. Imagine that the piece of work is going to be included in a time capsule to be read in one hundred years' time.

The entry may also include illustrations, an image, and/or emojis to support the creative piece. Keep in mind JCSP statements can be used in relation to this competition. Entries can be individual or group and can be in Irish or English.

Success Criteria Include:

1. Creative and original work produced by student/s
2. The posts are presented in a clear manner
3. Entries should have a minimum of 30 words and a maximum of 200 words
4. The piece can include images, illustrations or emojis

Closing date for the competition is Friday the 15th of May 2020.

Entering the competition accepts that the entry is the property of JCSP and may be used in posters or other materials, shown at in-service, and put on our website. As each student receives a personalised Certificate of Participation, please ensure an entry template is completed and returned which includes student's full name and school year.
