The seminar will allow participants to explore in depth the themes of both transitions and attainment within their broader context. Participants will consider the areas of inclusivity and teacher and school level expectations of students and the subsequent role these expectations play within the themes of Transitions and Attainment. Consideration will be given to how effective Teaching & Learning is the core activity for engineering change in schools. Participants will be afforded the time to collaborate and share their most effective teaching and learning practices which support students' transitions and attainment in the DEIS context. Participants will reflect on how the student, parent and teacher voice can support the implementation of the DEIS Action plan. Participants will be afforded the space to discuss the next steps for devising the DEIS Action plan through effective monitoring and evaluating of Targets and Actions.
