



On the day of the exhibition

It is important to remember that all schools are required to set up their own exhibit.

- Each school will be provided with a table with dimensions of approximately 1metre X 0.5metre and a display board for behind their table.
- It is a requirement that at all times, there will be a number of students and a teacher at individual exhibits during the exhibition, who will be able to explain their work and the learning involved to other students and teachers visiting their stand.
- They in turn will have an opportunity to view all the other exhibits.
- Numbers are limited to 10 per school to include teachers and parents.
- Principals are also welcome to attend this event.
- **It is imperative that students are supervised by the accompanying adults at all times.**
- A certificate will be available for all students present, and additional certificates will be available on the day for students who participated in the project back in school.
- The schools will be expected to take the exhibit with them after lunch.

Students will be given a copy of the 3-2-1 notepad (copy on the next page) and asked to think about the following throughout other school's presentation;

- 3 things you liked about the book
- 2 things you found out about the books
- 1 thing you would like to know more about

The students who made the Book should talk about the following when presenting their book;

- Describe the content of your book
- Why did you choose this topic for your book?
- Outline the process of creating your book
- What challenge(s) did you encounter in creating your book?
- What was your favourite part of making your book?
