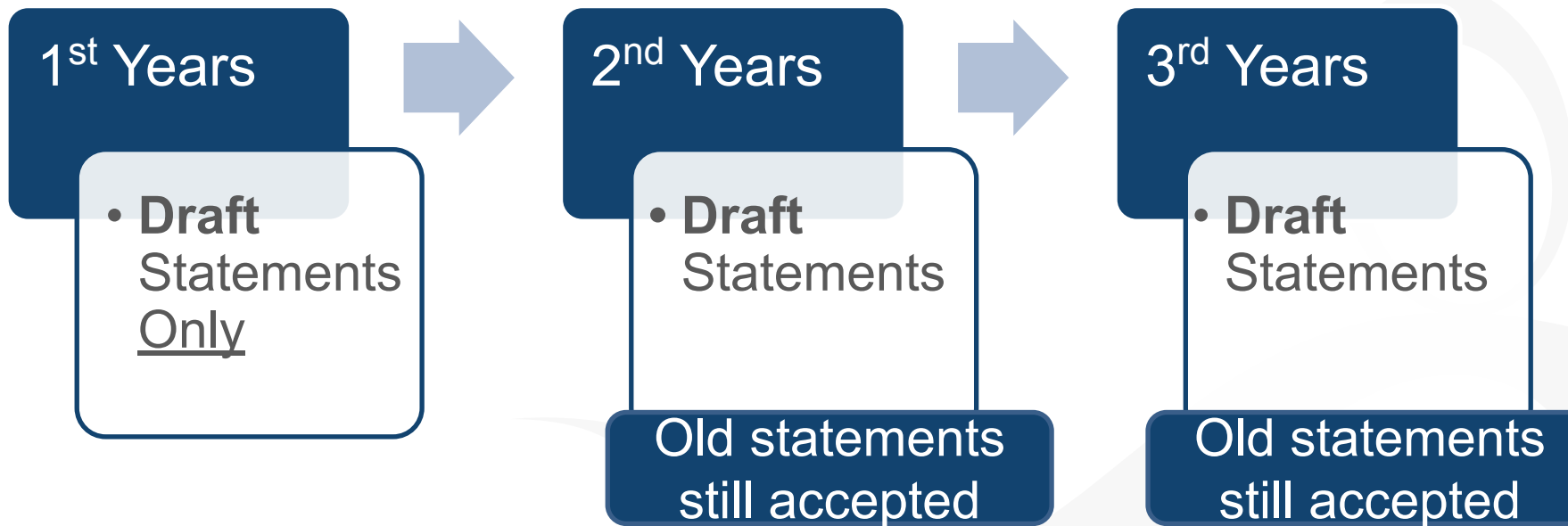


Phase 5: Wood Technology Statements 2022/2023
